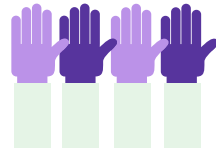

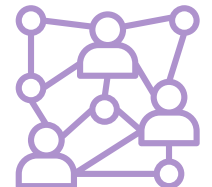

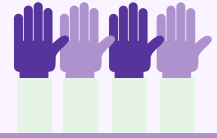
Peace at Home *Supportive Housing*

... housing placement services & 28 fully-equipped apartments for survivors of domestic violence and their children, ranging from studios to 3 bedroom units, with access to case management, counseling & other services needed to rebuild lives, free from violence.



Safe Refuge *Shelter*

... one of the largest emergency shelters for victims of domestic violence and their children in our state, with 22 beds and additional overflow space, providing 24/7 crisis counseling, safe shelter & support services to women, men, and children in their time of need in a safe, confidential location.



Advocacy for Justice *Court Advocacy*

... five advocates working in our region's civil & criminal courts providing advocacy, support & guidance through the judicial process to victims of family violence, helping them understand their legal rights & options, have their voices heard & connect them to services that address their individual & family needs.



Counseling & Healing *Individual & Groups*

... individual counseling, as well as weekly support groups, for survivors & those who have been impacted by domestic violence in the communities we serve, providing the support to empower, heal, and move forward from the devastating impacts of domestic violence in their lives.



Healthy Relationships *Prevention Education*

... critical training programs for police officers, employers, healthcare & other professionals to better reach and respond to victims in need, and prevention programs for children, youth & young adults to reduce risk factors and increase positive behaviors that lead to healthy relationships.
